The accommodation offers plenty of space for between 2-6 people, with a large living room that has double French doors opening onto the pretty garden, 3 double bedrooms (one having twin beds), 2 bathrooms, (one with shower and one with bath and shower over the bath), and a downstairs cloakroom with w.c.

There is a luxury fitted kitchen with built-in double oven, gas hobs, microwave, fridge, freezer, dishwasher, washing machine, toaster etc. The spacious living room has a dining area with a solid oak dining table and six French-style dining chairs.

The Cottage is centrally heated and in the living room there is a "living flame" gas fire with pebbles which gives the room a cosy focal point on autumn or winter evenings!

In addition to a large flat-screen television, there is a DVD player and video player, radio and CD player. We also provide a selection of DVDs which will appeal to all ages.

Linen is provided, and this service includes making up the beds ready for your arrival.

Outside there is a paved patio area next to the house with a large table complete with sun umbrella, six dining chair and sun loungers with plenty of space for dining out on hot summer days.

The cottage has its own garage and driveway with additional parking space in front of the property, so parking presents no problems for guests.

We provide extensive information on the local area for our guests such as recommendations on the best places for the scrumptious Devon Cream Tea, and where to find the most spectacular walks with views over coast and countryside.
